Employment, Manufacturing, Output, Housing, Inventories, Federal Reserve Policy, Energy, Consumer Confidence, Wages and Inflation data are just some examples of the type of data that is released that helps investors ascertain if the economy is expanding or contracting.

Astor Investment Management collects and analyzes economic data to determine the current state of the U.S. Economy. Astor publishes a score on a monthly basis that indicates if the economy is growing or contracting. The Astor Economic Index® is our proprietary reading of the U.S. Economy and is the cornerstone to Astor's investment process.




When the U.S. Economy is expanding and/or above historical averages, Astor is more comfortable owning equity-type investments.



When the U.S. Economy is contracting and/or below historical averages, Astor is less comfortable owning equity-type investments and more likely to invest in asset classes we believe will be less volatile and risky such as cash and fixed income.
